This could be a difficult issue - do we wear the olive green belts, the ACF belt or a Regimental belt? Do we only wear Stable belts with C95 at any time or only on formal parades?

As an officer, it is easy for me to get confused about such things and my instructors are usually much smarter than me!!! I have therefore already asked RSM Glaysher to write a new dress code for the County and this should be ready for issue soon. Your Company CSM will also be involved in this process. Once I have approved it, the information will also be made available on the County web-site and the aim is to have this ready by the end of this month.

In case you are interested, I have decided to wear the ACF belt!

Until the new dress code has been issued, you should follow the orders of your Company CSM."
